

10th Grade Make Up Lesson for Oct 14 – 20, '07: Introduction to John 11 – 21

*In order to do this Make Up lesson you will need your Bible Study book titled My Peace I Give You.

1. Read pages 6 & 7. The first 5 paragraphs summarize the major themes of the first 10 chapters of the Gospel of John. Write out and briefly explain two of the themes covered in these paragraphs.
2. Read pages 7 through 10. Write out an explanation of the meaning of glory in the Gospel of John.

Beginning on the bottom of page 9 and continuing through most of page 10, the text explains how John's use of word Glory contains an apparent contradiction. Write out an explanation of how God can be glorified through the death of Jesus on the cross.

3. Read the bottom of page 10 through page 13. Write out a brief explanation of how John describes the Holy Spirit in his Gospel.

Note: On page 11 it says that Church scholars have some questions about whether the apostle John wrote the Gospel or if this Gospel was written by others members of the early Church using the insights that the apostle John taught.

Note: On pages 11 & 12 the text states that the Gospel of John is so full of meaning that it will take many readings to understand the depth of each passage.

At the bottom of page 12 and on page 13, the text explains John's use of the term "the Jew". Write out a brief explanation of what John means when referring to "the Jews".
